







The Challenge

Pierce Pepin Cooperative Services (PPCS) was established in 1937 to deliver reliable, sustainable, and affordable energy to rural Wisconsin communities. Today, PPCS serves over 7,000 members across Pierce, Pepin, St. Croix, and Buffalo counties. The cooperative recognized that the lack of ubiquitous broadband was compromising members' quality of life—from students having to drive into town to complete their homework to seniors without in-home connectivity required to monitor their medical devices.

PPCS knew they needed to bridge the critical broadband connectivity gap, so members didn't get left behind. In 2021, PPCS launched a broadband subsidiary, SwiftCurrent Connect (SwiftCurrent), to bring high-speed fiber-optic internet to rural western Wisconsin. Led by PPCS president and chief executive officer Nate Boettcher, the initiative required an experienced and reliable partner to help turn his vision into reality.





The Results

With a robust fiber broadband network in place, PPCS plans to connect load controllers, thermostats, and electric vehicles to the grid to help members reduce their energy consumption. SwiftCurrent has also allowed them to connect one of the first data centers in western Wisconsin. In the meantime, SwiftCurrent is well on their way to connecting every home without access to fiber and high-speed internet. To date, they have surpassed 3,500 members and continue to grow.

The Calix Broadband Platform and integrated managed services have had a transformational impact on rural communities in western Wisconsin. Students no longer have to drive to the nearest town to complete their homework—they now have access to educational opportunities previously not available to them. Likewise, the SwiftCurrent fiber broadband infrastructure can easily handle bandwidth—intensive teleworking applications. This helps attract new residents more easily, driving further economic development.

Seniors and those requiring at-home medical care are also benefiting significantly. A consistent connection enables people to regularly check in on their elderly family members. Wearable devices can also be monitored more reliably. For example, a local woman whose husband wears a connected heart device can now sleep at night, knowing that data is being transmitted to health professionals who can alert emergency services if needed.
